

Work Scope	<p>Definition: Contextual Editing</p> <p>Contextual editing is not textbook literature editing– edit words for spelling, grammar, punctuation based on the context and not about sentence construction, style, or tone of the phrase – without altering the original meaning of the content.</p> <p>Contextual Editors' job:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • take out sentence fragments that are short and beyond reconstruction; • put proper punctuation marks to clarify meaning– for example quotation marks (“ ”) before and after phrases in interviews; • research and correct the spelling of cities, countries, celebrities, politicians, sports figures etc. • delete unnecessary identical paragraphs
Objectives	The challenge for the final output is to provide the most meaningful script, consistent names, correct spellings and punctuation marks.
